On 31 March 2024, the existing FREE garden bin service came to an end, and has been replaced garden waste subscription service. Residents who have not paid for the new service will not emptied. If a sticker hasn't arrived where details of all subscribers on the database in their and bins should be collected. If residents ordered an additional bin/s as part of their subscribers these bins will be sent once a bin has been delivered.

Because of this change from 1 April 2024 food waste will no longer be accepted as part of the collections. By law the council cannot charge for the collection of food waste and now the waste service is moving over to a charge about the food waste has to be excluded.
